Routes to Reconstruction: The Socio-Cultural Dimensions of Emerging Health Care Needs in a Globalized Europe was a two day workshop held at the Centre. With several invited speakers the group talked about exploring issues that arise in connection with female genital (re)constructive surgery in the aftermath of female genital cutting (FGC) and in other contexts where such surgery is a possibility. The workshop also dealt with theorizations of the body, the experiences of those who seek (re)-constructive surgery and the routes they take, the interventions that are available and associated concerns.
